



Instructions for retrieving a single employee record via the Builder Prime API

The app should submit a GET request to:

```
https://<builder-prime-subdomain>.builderprime.com/api/employees/v1/<employeeId>
```

Replace `<builder-prime-subdomain>` with the specific subdomain specified by the customer.

The internal `employeeId` field must be specified in the request path in order to retrieve the record. If this value is not specified, it will attempt to retrieve a list of employees instead.

The request must include the secret key created in the Builder Prime app with `employees.read` scope as the value for a header key of `x-api-key`.
